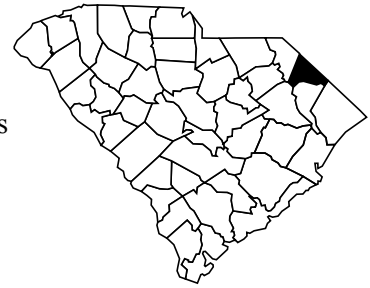


Dillon County:

Located in northeastern South Carolina, this county has a large timber industry. Although much of the county is composed of wetlands along the Little Pee Dee River and its tributaries, these contrasted with sandhills immediately adjacent. These wetlands are little disturbed and house an interesting complex of plants and animals.

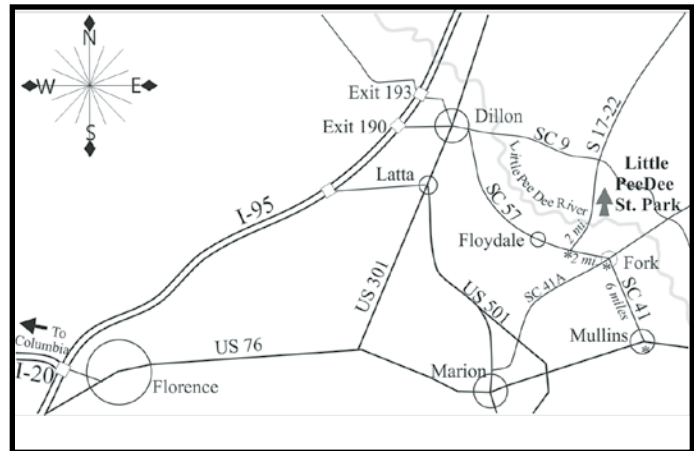

The threat of rain did little to dampen the enthusiasm of the participants on this day. The nature trail took us from lakeside to the edge of the sandhills. The number and species of oaks gave the botanists a good challenge. The dark threatening conditions kept the birds quiet, so we saw few of those, but the insects were moving. The lake edge and beaver pond gave a nice look at aquatic insects and plants. The Beaver did not appear but gnaw marks on the trees were fresh, indicating there were Beavers in the area.

Directions: The park is between SC 57 and SC 9 on State Park Road (SR17-22), 11 miles southeast of Dillon (Exits 190 & 193 off Interstate 95). The park headquarters is to the east of State Park Road.

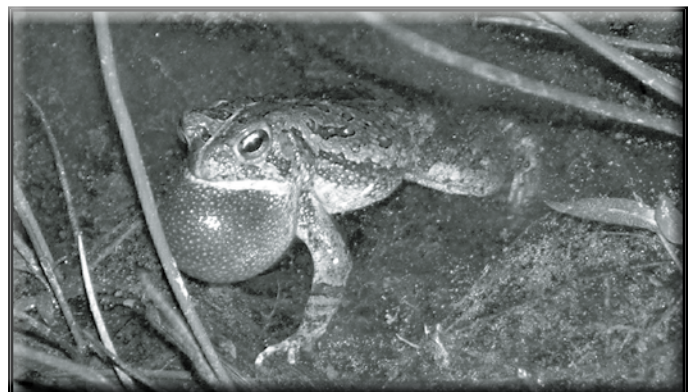
